**Lost or Forgotten Lunches**

- Peanut Butter, Jelly, & Bread are available for those who forget their lunch.
- Extra utensils, plates, & cups are available if dunk bags are forgotten.

**Unit Basket** A place to keep your camp "stuff"

Your unit basket includes:

- First Aid Kit
- Trash bag (large plastic replaced daily)
- Hand wash set (includes dunk line, clothespins, paper towels, soap, a bleach bottle for water)

Unit baskets are stored overnight in the shed. No food or liquids overnight!

**Firestarting Equipment**

Each cookout day, you will receive:

- Dish soap, brush, & SOS
- Matches & Firestarters
- Baking Soda (to put out grease fires)
- Bleach for disinfecting dishes
- Pot Holders & Tongs
- 3 Buckets
- Lemonade & Pitcher
- Towels
- Charcoal

**Cooking Equipment**

On cookout days, each unit will receive a blue equipment basket containing the cooking equipment as requested on the Shed Order Form.

- Please include your menu on your Shed Order Form. Shed staff may need to make substitutions to your order. **BE FLEXIBLE!**
- When picking up equipment, send 3 or 4 campers to help - it's a lot to carry!
- Rinse all items before first cookout, they have been in storage all year. Wash all items thoroughly before returning.
- Dispose of all used SOS pads.
- When cooking over fire, generously soap the outside of buckets and pots & pans. It makes it easier to clean.
- Use paper grocery bags for cutting boards.
- Units staying overnight will receive all shed equipment for both dinner and breakfast on Wednesday afternoon.
- Toasting forks must be cleaned.
- Hatchets and/or knives may be checked out by aides or unit leaders only.

**Ice Cream**

May be ordered twice during camp on non-cookout days. Be sure to include your choice of flavor (strawberry, orange, or rootbeer). The following will be provided:

- Ice cream maker
- Rock salt
- Ice (pick it up just before you start)
- Condensed milk
- Can opener
- Serving spoon
- Cones
- Soda
- Fruit (if applicable)

Thoroughly clean and dry ice cream makers- rock salt eats away at the metal! Remember, competition is tough for Mother Hubbard's Bone!

**Watermelon**

May be ordered twice during camp. Remember to look for your knife!
