

Diamond Crest Girl Scout Day Camp Admissions Policy

The highest priority is to take all on-time applications, but we recognize that it may not be possible to do this.

CAMPERS (Entering grades 1-7)

On-time applications will be accepted based on the following criteria:

1. Unit availability at the grade level, with higher priority in staffing units given to the higher grade levels
2. Child of staff member
3. Current **Diamond Crest** Girl Scout member registered by January 1 of current year
4. Current non-Diamond Crest Girl Scout member registered by January 1 of current year
5. Resident of Diamond Crest Service Unit (San Carlos, Belmont, Redwood Shores and parts of San Mateo) or enrolled in a school within its boundaries
6. By lottery for remaining spaces

(For example, an on-time non-scout would be considered for placement ahead of a late scout.)

Admissions decisions regarding siblings are made independently from each other.

Late applicants will be considered according to unit availability and the date the application is received.

AIMS (Aides in Training, entering grade 7) spend their time at camp preparing for their future roles as program Aides the following year (entering 8th grade). It is necessary that girls registering, as AIMS are able to attend camp the entire two weeks of the program. The administrative team is continually striving to provide all of our campers an excellent camp experience. Well-trained Aides are critical to this goal!

AIDES (Entering grades 8, 9 and 10):

The Aides unit will be filled to a maximum enrollment of 100 using the following criteria for on-time registrations:

1. Child of Staff Member
2. Current Diamond Crest Girl Scout member registered by January 1 of the current year
3. Current non-Diamond Crest Girl Scout member registered by January 1 of the current year
4. Completion of AIT course at Diamond Crest Day Camp or equivalent (to be submitted)
5. Years of experience and evaluations as a Diamond Crest Day Camp Aide
6. Years as a camper at Diamond Crest Day Camp

Applicants may be asked to submit further information

Any applicant who has not completed the Diamond Crest AIT Training will be placed in the AIT unit for the full 2 weeks of camp.
